YWCA ENCORE^{plus} provides outreach and educational information to women regarding breast and cervical health. The program also provides referrals to free screening services to women who are uninsured or whose insurance does not cover the cost of these services. Education sessions are available in English, Spanish and Portuguese. Outreach Specialists also offer transportation and accompany women to their appointments.

Breast cancer surgery can often cause a woman discomfort, limit her energy and strength, and restrict her mobility. It may leave her feeling alone with questions unanswered. YWCA Waterpals is a program combining floor and water exercises to assist women in regaining vitality and function after their surgery. By participating with others recovering from breast cancer surgery, women may learn through information exchange, mutual experience and support.
